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**Program Terms:**

Recipients of Graduate Division funding are limited to \$33,500 in stipend support per 12-month academic year (Fall, Spring, and the following summer). Summer Grant recipients are further restricted to receiving no more than \$6,000 in total support for summer 2014; this \$6,000 summer cap includes not only fellowship awards (from the Graduate Division, your department, or external sources), but also salary from summer employment (GSR, GSI, etc.).

If a Summer Grant recipient exceeds either of these caps for the 2013 - 14 year, it is the responsibility of the recipient to notify Graduate Fellowships via email ([gradfell@berkeley.edu](mailto:gradfell@berkeley.edu)) for adjustment of the Summer Grant award.

Recipients of Summer Grant awards (even those awarded to support off - campus activities) must enroll in at least three Summer Sessions units at Berkeley; independent study units count toward this requirement. Note that Summer Grants cover fees for only three summer units; *enrollment in additional units will incur extra fees that are not covered by this program or the department.*

The total number of Summer Grant awards is subject to availability of funds. Therefore, meeting the eligibility requirements does not guarantee receipt of an award.
